We will be hosting a 'Where's Wally Fun Run' in school during the week beginning 20th May. Nursery children will have the opportunity each day to join the 'Where's Wally Fun Run'

Children can choose to either run, walk or create their own unique movement around the course. The nursery children will be encouraged to complete one lap of the field or playground each day with the nursery practitioners joining in too, in support of transforming children's lives through literacy.
